A CONFLICT
is...

- **Struggle or Problem between two or more people**
- **Equal balance of power**
- **There is a possible solution**



A MEAN
MOMENT
is...

- **Being mean or hurtful to someone on purpose**
 - **Isolated event**
 - **Not ongoing**
- **Doesn't happen regularly**



TEASING is...

- **Friends or classmates are having fun with each other**
- **Both participate equally**
- **Both are happy**
- **Nobody is getting hurt**

**If it stops being
fun/funny/equal it can lead to
conflict or bullying**



BULLYING
is...

- **Repeated/Ongoing**
- **Unwanted, aggressive behavior**
- **Real or perceived power imbalance**
- **Has been told to stop and has not stopped the behavior**
- **Leveling**

THE 6 TYPES OF BULLYING



PHYSICAL BULLYING

any physical contact that hurts a person like hitting, kicking or punching



VERBAL BULLYING

name calling, jokes about or offensive remarks about a person's religion, gender, ethnicity, appearance or socioeconomic status



INDIRECT BULLYING

excluding others from a group, spreading lies, secrets, rumors or exaggerated stories about someone



SOCIAL ALIENATION

pointing out differences in others, excluding others from a group, and spreading rumors



INTIMIDATION BULLYING

using threats to frighten others



CYBER BULLYING

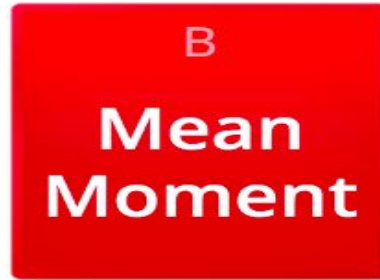
sending pictures, messages or information using electronic media, computers and cell phones

Why do people BULLY?

- * they think it will make them “fit in”
- *to be powerful...when they aren't
 - *peer pressure
 - *copying others
 - *to get attention
- *they are jealous of others
 - *to get something
- *to seem cool or be superior
 - *they have been bullied
 - *they are insecure
- *they don't know how to act correctly
 - *immaturity
